This funding will be used to

- Meet the target of 90% of students receiving C or above in English and Maths
- Meet Prep reading targets of 95% of students reading PM level 9
- Meeting targets for extending high performing (A and B) students in;
 - Year 1 to 6 60% in English, 60% in Maths
 - Prep 70% in English, 85% in Maths

Our initiatives include

- Providing focused and intensive teaching and capacity building of staff with a focus on meeting school targets for students receiving C or above for English and Maths, as well as meeting targets for A and B students
- Develop teacher capability to improve digital pedagogies practice
- Provide targeted support for students not achieving benchmarks in reading in years Prep to Year 6.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employment of a STLaN (1.0) Years 3-6 to build teacher capability and pedagogy to support student differentiation strategies \$90,281
- Employment of a Support Teacher (0.8) with targeted students \$78,000
- Employment of a Digital Pedagogies Support Teacher (1.0) to enhance access to the Australian Curriculum - \$85,000
